All entries must be typed or printed on a 2010 Region 1 Entry form (may be copied) and include:

Four original handwritten signatures: Owner, Rider, Trainer and Coach, if applicable.

Photocopy of negative Coggins test dated 12 months of show date.

Copies of USEF and USDF cards for Owner, Trainer, Rider and Coach (if applicable) must be included with entry. Emergency number must be included.

Copies of USDF Horse I.D. number or Lifetime Recording are required for all horses entered. USEF Annual or Lifetime Recording is only required for GAIG Q classes.

Refunds: Before closing date, full refund less \$20.00 Office Fee. No refunds after closing date or for "acts of god", which require management to cancel classes on day of competition.

AWARDS

- Trophy and 6 Ribbons: Training through FEI Levels.
- High Score Award at each Level (Does not include Musical FS or FEI Tests for 4, 5 or 6 Yr. Old Horses).
- LVDA High Score Member Award. All paid members of LVDA are automatically eligible for this award.
- LVDA High Score Jr/YR Member Award. All paid Jr/YR members of LVDA are automatically eligible for this award.
- USDF/Dover Adult Amateur Medal - Awarded to the highest scoring AA in the class. Rider must be a USEF & USDF member and receive a score of 58% or higher.
- Patt Bealer Memorial Award- Awarded to the highest scoring training level amateur rider.

FOOTING

- Two standard dressage rings—one ring is sand and screening mixture and the other ring is sand and rubber. Enclosed warm-up ring with sand and rubber mixture. Grass and lunging areas.

OTHER

- Food available on grounds

All dogs must be leashed - those allowing their dogs to run loose will be asked to leave.

IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT PROTECTIVE HEAD GEAR BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHEN MOUNTED.

Bridle numbers must be worn at all times outside trailer.

Sharps containers for needles are located outside the secretary's booth and by the water hose behind Ring 1.

Competitors, please take note of the awards you may have earned throughout the day and kindly remember to pick them up from the show secretary by days' end.

Also, please remember to pick up your Musical FS cassette/CD's or arrangements will have to be made at a later date to obtain them.

DIRECTIONS

I-78, exit 21, Rt. 412 South (approx. 5.3 mi.) to Rt. 212 East (approx. 1.8 mi.) to Rt. 412 South (approx. 4.8 mi.) to Church Hill Rd. (approx. 1.5 mi.) to Rt. 611 South (approx. 0.9 mi. to show grounds).

PA Turnpike, exit 27 Willow Grove, Rt. 611 North to show grounds at Bucks County Horse Park, Revere, PA. The Park is approx. 30 miles north of the exit.

USEF MOTORIZED VEHICLE RULE- Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

HOLD HARMLESS CLAUSE- Understanding that horse sports may be hazardous and dangerous, even leading to permanent injury or death, each owner, rider, spectator, and other participant assumes any and all risk of loss or injury and agrees to hold harmless, regardless of negligent acts or omissions, the Lehigh Valley Dressage Association, organizer, show committee, all horse show personnel, and the Bucks County Horse Park.
